***New Category Definitions --- Please read all instructions***

1. A separate form must be filled out in full for each entry. Completed and signed entry forms should be received no later than March 31, 2020 together with fee of \$5.00 for each entry. Late entries may be accepted if the maximum has not been reached but may not appear in the program; a late fee of \$5.00 will be assessed. Entry forms may be submitted by mail to Kathryn Schexnayder, 1220 FM 1970, Carthage, TX 75633. Make checks payable to *Piney Woods Quilt Festival*. 2. Quilts should have a 4" sleeve, **top of the sleeve not more than 90"** from the bottom edge. **Sleeves are required on all quilts.**
3. Quilts must be delivered to the Carthage Civic Center, 1702 S. Adams St, Carthage, TX between the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM on Tuesday April 14, 2020 or by mail no later than April 5.\* The Civic Center is located on the loop at the intersection with S. Adams St., near the baseball complex. Judging will be by a certified judge.
4. Quilts must be picked up after the show Saturday, April 18, between 4:45 and 5:00 PM. No item will be released before 4:45 PM. This allows for careful handling and orderly release. The person who has signed the entry form must present the pink copy to pick up the quilt unless prior arrangement has been approved. Quilt insurance is the responsibility of the entrant. We strongly encourage everyone to have a permanent label on the back of each quilt.

\*For mailed entries, please contact Kathryn Schexnayder at the address in item 1 above. Shipped quilts must be received no later than April 5.

**Category Descriptions: Categories 100 through 600 will have quilt tops constructed by a single maker and Category 700 "Group Quilts" will be for quilts with tops that have elements by more than one maker.** Please read all category descriptions below and check the category that best describes your quilt, considering the most complex feature of the entry, e.g., no embroidery or applique in pieced categories, etc. Categories **100 through 500** are bed quilts with a minimum perimeter of 220". Quilts in the 200-250 category will have a width up to 72" depending on the number of entries in that and the next category. Category 600 is for smaller than bed sized quilts, mini-quilts and quilted projects. **In the judging, no individual may be awarded more than one place per category.** Show personnel reserve the right to change a category if warranted or assign as appropriate for our show. Including a photo will aid in proper category assignment.
